
How to ship safely...



Microphones and related electronics shall be protected well during transport. Shipping damage is easily avoided though:

- 1. Do not use worn out or crushed boxes, as they will get squashed when stacked. Highly fragile items should be double-boxed. Mouldy boxes and padding may be rejected (sorry, I'm allergic...)
- 2. Use clean, dry and dust-free cushioning material only. Condenser microphones in particular are sensitive to any kind of contamination.
- 3. Protect microphones and electronics against dust and moisture. An inner bubble wrap is ideal and offers good shock protection at the same time.
- 4. Stuff gaps with bubble wrap, foam chips or crumpled paper, to prevent heavy items from bumping against each other (power supplies in particular)
- 5. Please use adhesive tape for outer packaging only. This simplifies unpacking at our end and saves valuable working time.
- 6. LASTLY: Help us protect the environment by packaging in a way that allows easy reuse of all packaging material. *NO waste* is the best waste ! :-)
